Clothing and Footwear

Policy Statement/Goals

At Sk'elep School, we are proud of our students' appearance, and the Board of Governors expects all students at Sk'elep School to dress appropriately at all times of the year. The Board believes that the way students dress reflects the pride students have in themselves and in Sk'elep School.

Regulations

1. Parents should place the child's name on all clothing and belongings that are brought to school. Any items of clothing or belongings that are lost or misplaced are placed in the lost and found box located at the entrance of the School.
2. Students must remove all outdoor clothing, hats, ball caps, and footwear before entering the classrooms and put them in their lockers. Students must remove excessive mud, dirt, and snow from their footwear before entering the school.
3. All students must wear footwear specific to indoor use. White soled, non-marking runners only are permitted on the gymnasium floor.
4. For the purpose of maintaining the floors, and for safety in case of evacuation, students are requested to keep a pair of shoes at school, to be worn at school, and designated as indoor footwear.
5. Shoes must be worn at all times for safety and in case of fire. During the winter season, it is advisable to have a second pair of shoes for inside use only. In the event that a student does not have an extra pair of shoes for indoor designation, the Principal will have discretion to allow socks.
6. All students are expected to dress in clothes that are suitable for school activities and a learning environment. The following types of clothing are not allowed:
 - shirts/tops with midriff showing
 - spaghetti straps
 - halter tops
 - short shorts
 - short skirts
 - muscle shirts
 - low hanging shorts/pants/jeans
 - shirts with inappropriate slogans or messages
